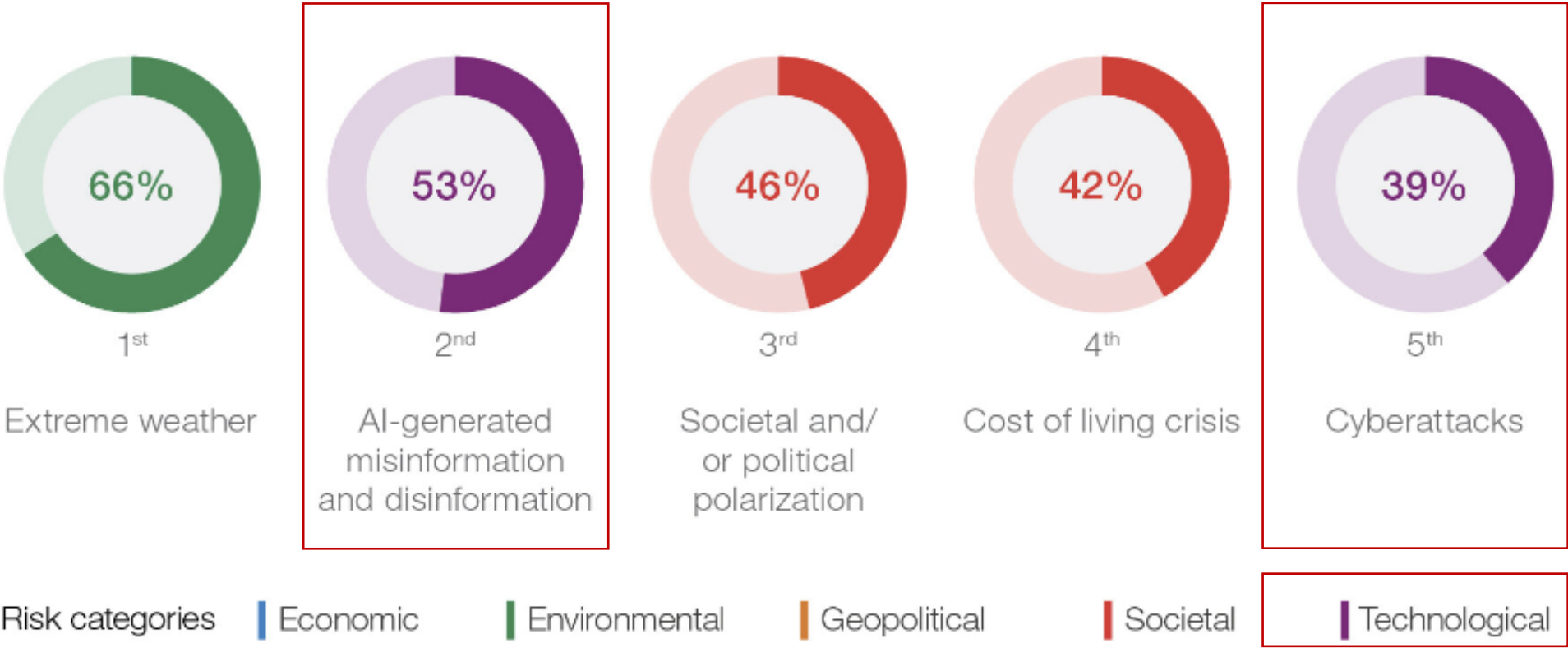

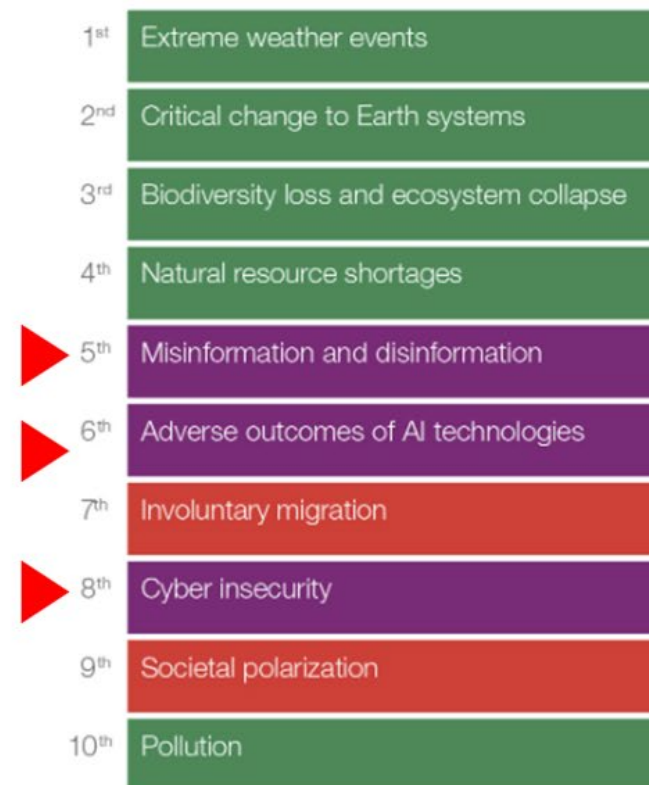

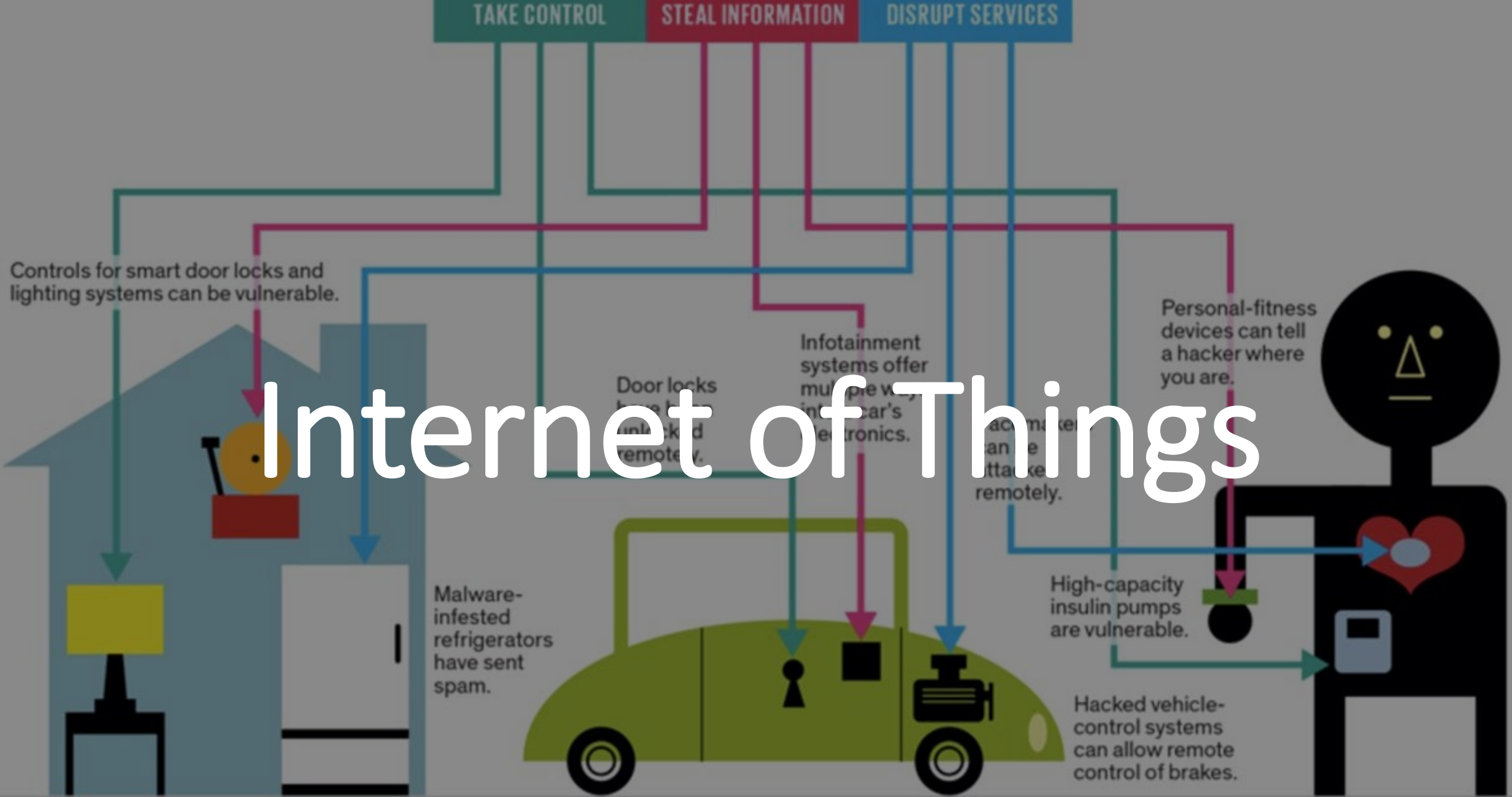

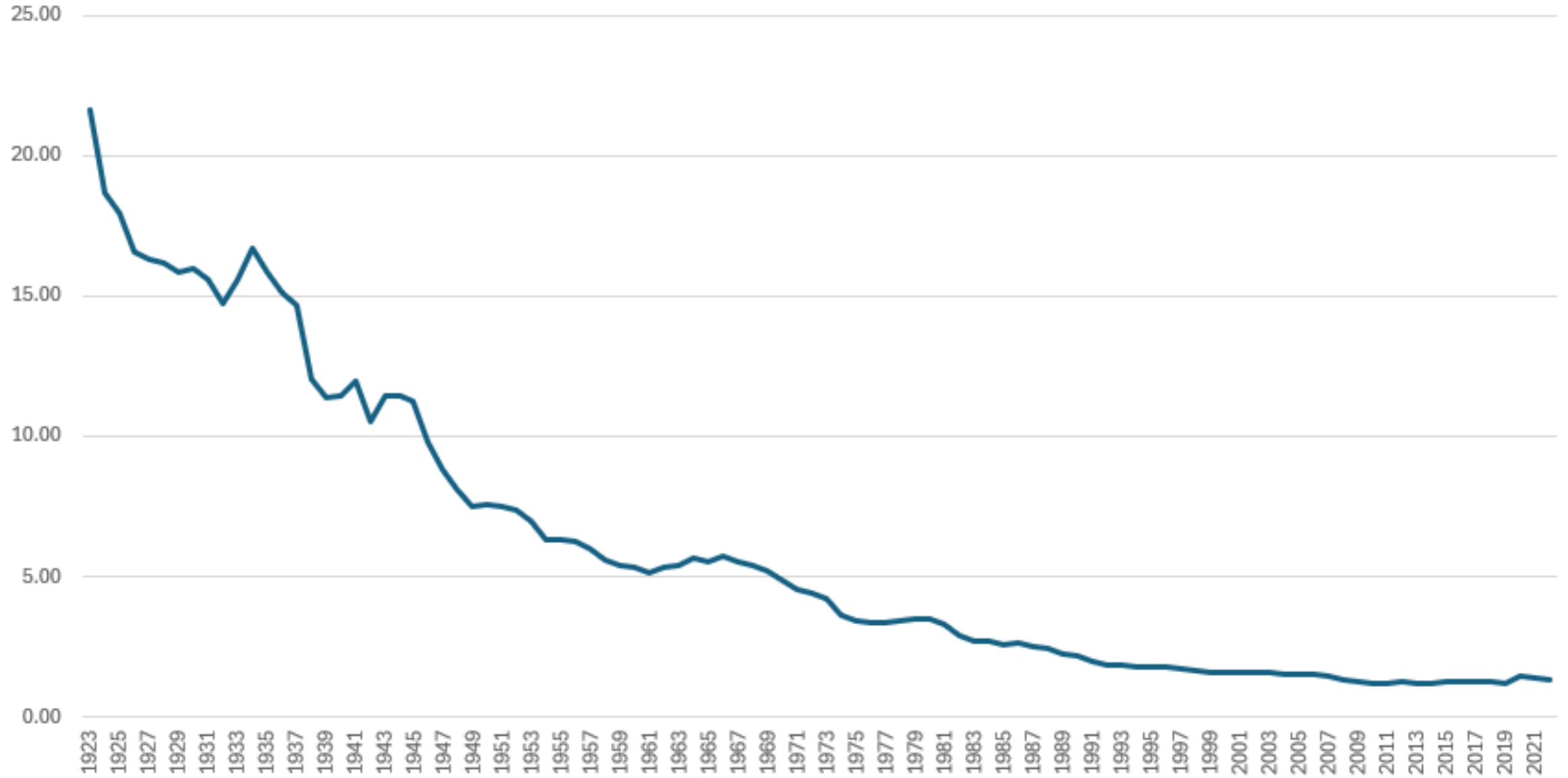








Death Rate in US Per 100,000,000 Vehicle Miles

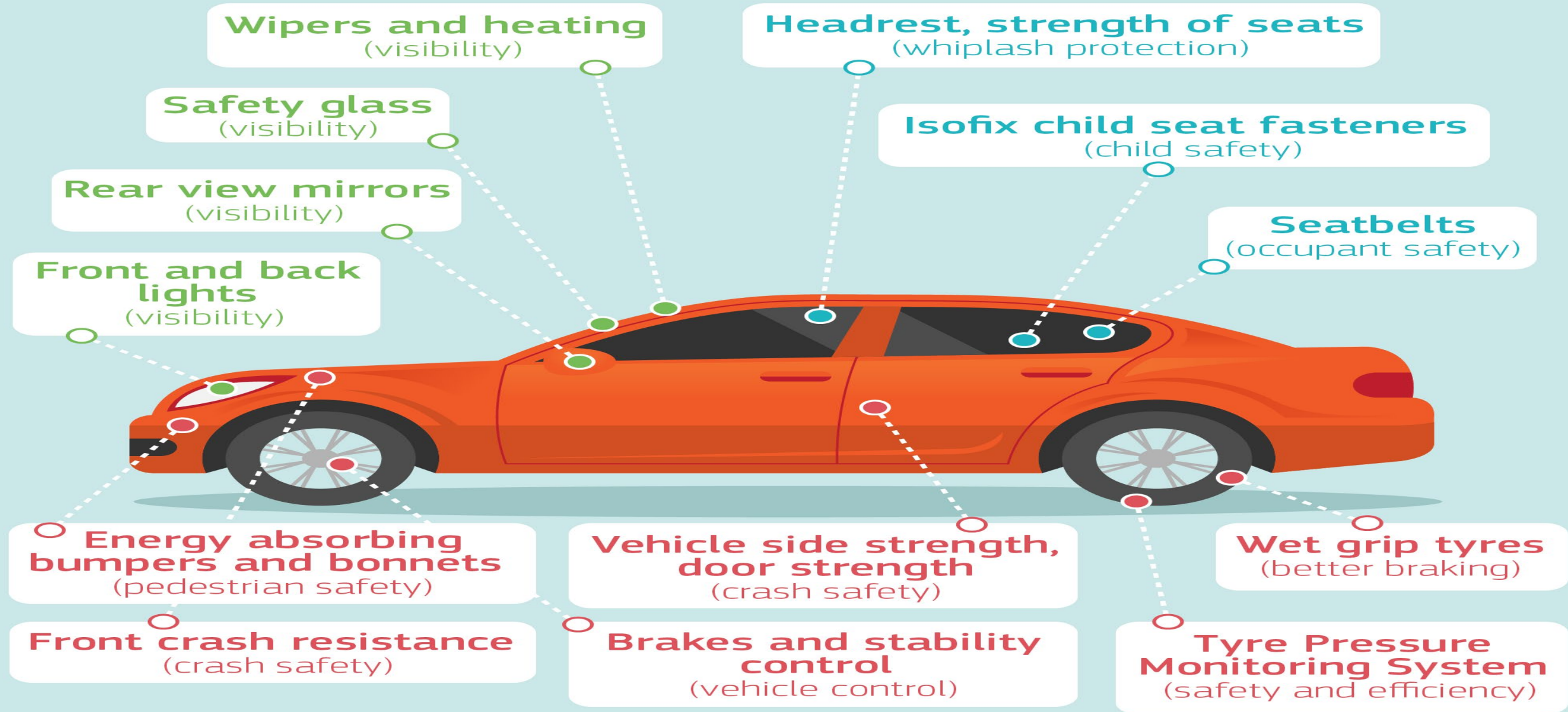

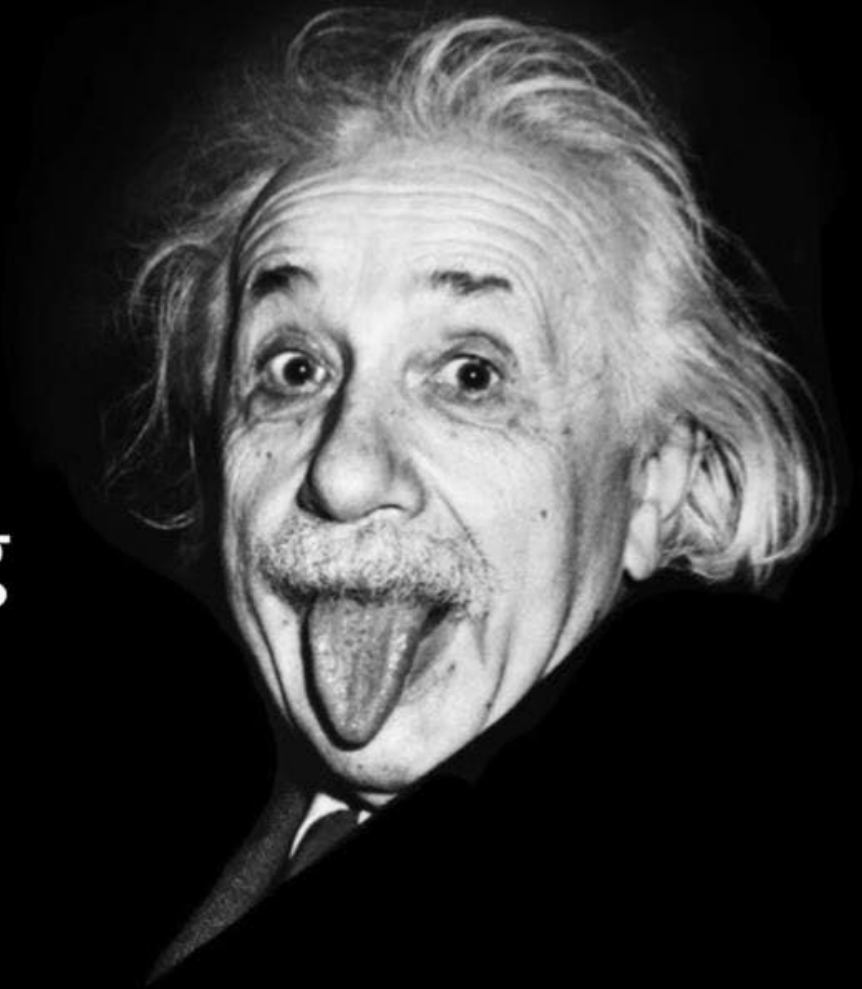
