- Earlier this year I appeared on CNN



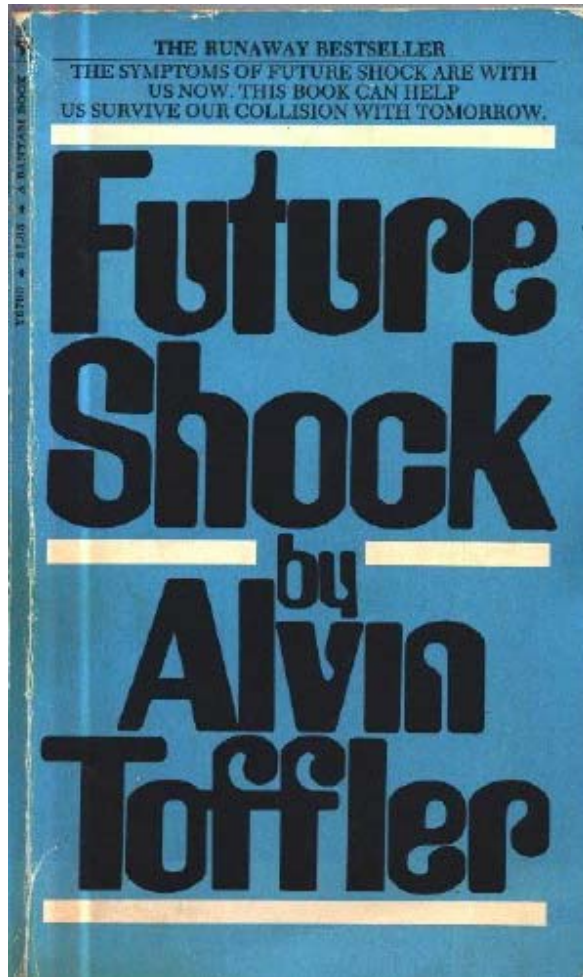
And I received a phone call...

FUTURE SHOCK- quotes from Alvin Toffler

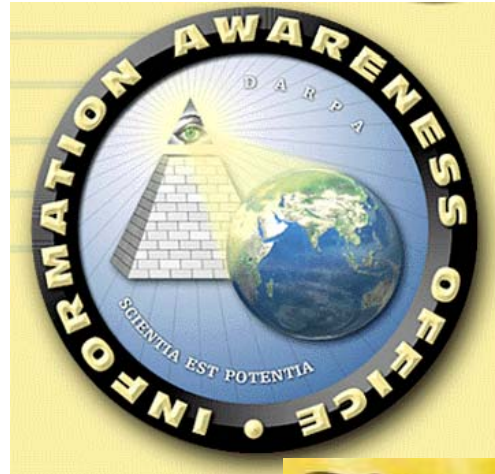
- Future shock is the shattering stress and disorientation that we induce in individuals by subjecting them to too much change in too short a time.

People see conspiracies everywhere!

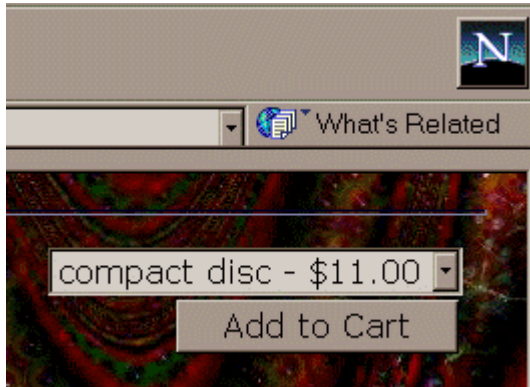


Judith C can't believe what is happening to her

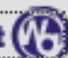

- Is anti-malware enough?

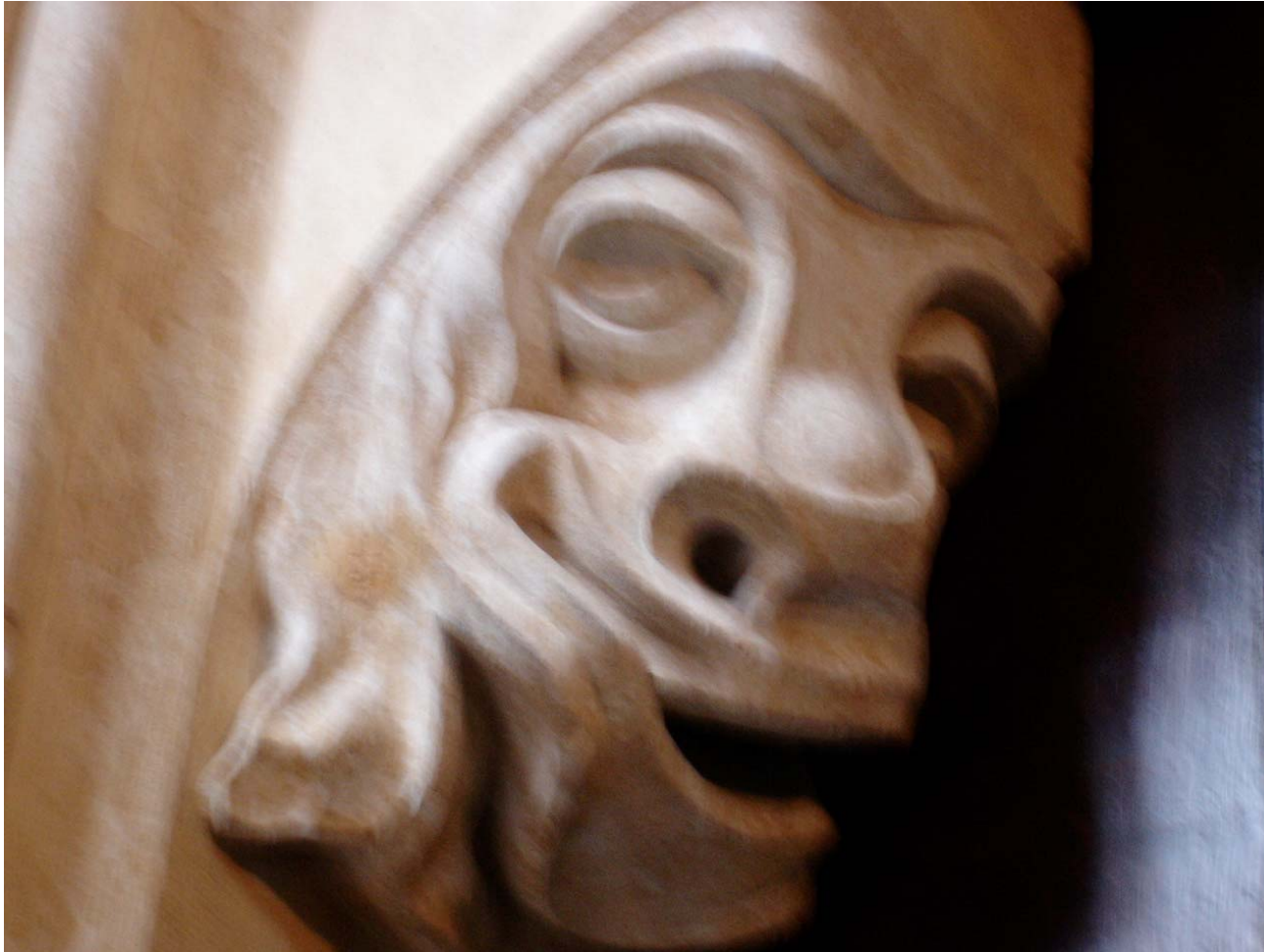
